<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Transcendence (Beyond)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Using singing in worship as a way to reflect, pray and connect with God.• Exploring sacred and reflective music.• Providing moments of stillness, reflection and awe through listening and singing.• Engaging with musical theatre and songs that explore deeper themes such as hope, courage, forgiveness and perseverance.• Recognising how music can help us explore life's "big questions".• Encouraging children to consider how music can connect them to something bigger than themselves.	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Nature/ World</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Exploring a wide range of musical styles, traditions and cultures.• Appreciating the beauty and creativity found in music from around the world.• Experiencing live performances beyond the classroom to broaden cultural awareness.• Recognising music as an important part of cultural identity and community life.• Encouraging thoughtful listening and reflection on the world around us through music.• Understanding that music connects us to the wider world and different communities.• Celebrating creativity during an Arts Week, recognising the beauty of artistic expression.
