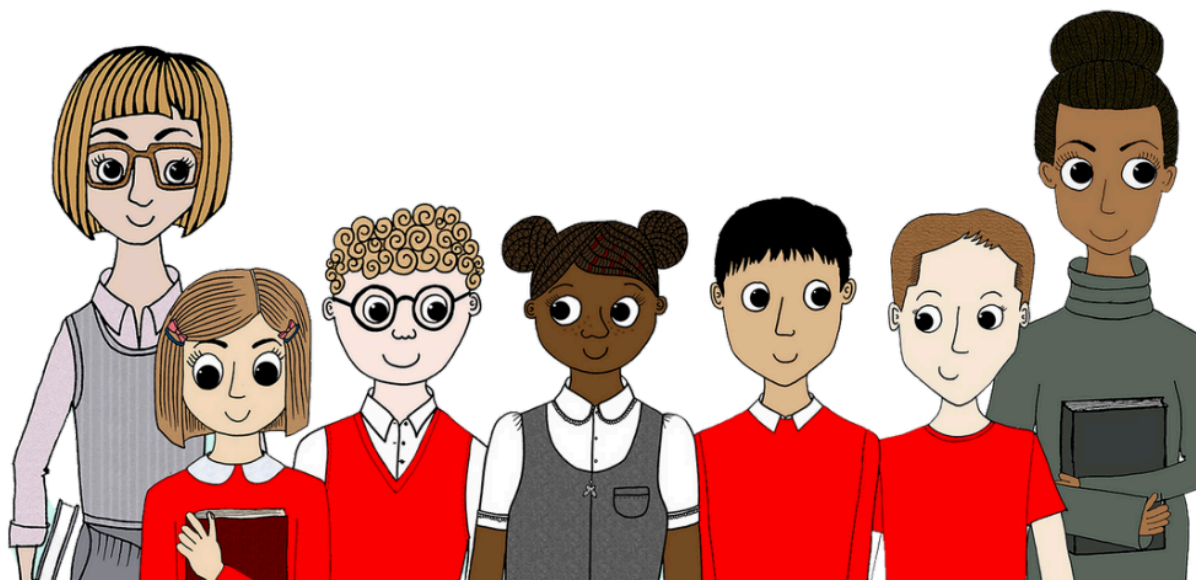

Our rules are here to help us. They make sure our school is a lovely place for all of us. Here are some of the things you can do to follow these rules at school.



# READY



How will you show you are ready for school?

When you are **ready** for learning you will:

Wear your uniform smartly and correctly

Arrive on time ready

Hair tied up if longer than your shoulders

Sit smartly and quietly on a chair (with two feet on the floor)  
or carpet (legs crossed)

Sit up straight

Show you are ready to listen by looking at your teacher

Line up smartly, quietly and correctly

Shirts tucked in, buttons done up and ties on

Earrings out, watches off and long hair tied up for PE lessons

Be ready to try your best

Talk at the correct time using the correct level of noise

Listen and follow instructions straight away

Have the correct equipment or PE kit ready

Concentrate and try your best in lessons



# RESPECTFUL

Riku helps us remember to show respect to everyone at school.

To be **respectful** we should:

Take it in turns to speak and listen

Speak kindly to our friends and teachers

Take care and appreciate our equipment and our environment

Speak respectfully to all staff

Speak respectfully to all deanery friends

Speak respectfully to our community

Be patient and take turns when speaking

Show your best in your work

Show you are listening when an adult is talking

Think about what you say before you say it

Use kind words

Look after and share resources carefully with your class

friends and put them back correctly

Be helpful when the opportunity occurs by doing things like

holding the door open



# SAFE

Shiloh reminds us how everyone at school can keep each other safe.

To help us all stay **safe** you can:

Stop and listen to adults that are giving you instructions

Walk calmly and safely around school

Walk to your lines

Act on instruction promptly and calmly

Keep your hands to yourself

Talk to an adult if you feel unsafe

Tell an adult if you see something unsafe like a spillage

Use equipment correctly and safely

Wear the correct PE kit

Earrings out and long hair tied up for PE lessons


Don't wear jewellery

Only wear silver or gold stud earrings to school

Sit on your chair with both feet and chair legs on the floor

Sit with your legs crossed on the carpet

Keep your environment tidy - tuck in chairs, put rubbish into the correct bins, put away equipment
