



### **Setting up a new band:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup – Add Band*
- Fill in the required information.

### **Adding pupils:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup – Add Individual*
- Enter the pupil's name and choose your class from the Maths Group drop down menu.

### **Grouping children within your class:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup*
- From the list to the right of your Maths Group name, select *Set the Tables*.
- Drag pupil names into the different groups.
- You can rename the groups by clicking on the group name.

### **Setting the tables for your groups:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup*
- From the list to the right of your Maths Group name, select *Set the Tables*.
- Click on *Set the schedule*.

There are now two options:

- 1) Manually select the tables you would like the group to focus on each week.
  - 2) Enable *automatic training mode* – this means that children's progress and new tables will be tracked and set automatically.
- The teacher-set tables are used for the Garage and Arena games – please make sure that the children know this. Other games use all tables up to 12x12, which may not be appropriate for all children.

### **Accessing your class heatmap:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup*
- From the list to the right of your Maths Group name, select *Stats*.
- Then go to *Band Headlines*.

- The heat map will show you which tables your class can answer quickly and which ones they answer more slowly.

### **Accessing individual heatmaps:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup*
- From the list to the right of your Maths Group name, select *Stats*.
- Then go to *Individual Scores*.
- The children in your class will be listed. Click on *stats* next to the name of the individual child.

### **Checking when children were last on TTR:**

- Go to *My School – Pupil Setup*.
- From the list to the right of your Maths Group name, select *Manage Users*.
- The children in your class will be listed and the date they last played is recorded in the far right column.
- Clicking on the *Last Played* column heading will sort the children in date order.

### **Setting tournaments:**

There are two types of tournaments: Rock Slams and Battle of the Bands.

#### ***Rock Slams:***

- These are 1:1 challenges that the children can set themselves.
- Teachers can set limits for who the children can challenge, e.g. within their own band or year group.
- Go to *Tournaments – Rock Slams*

#### ***Battle of the Bands:***

- These allow different bands to compete against each other. You choose which two Bands you want to compete and set when you want the Battle to commence and when you want it to finish. During these times, any points that children score in any of the games will count towards their Band's score.
- Go to *Tournaments – Battle of the Bands*
- Make sure that Pupil's view of the band battles will only display their Rock Name by clicking and selecting from the drop down list.
- Click + *New Battle*.
- Select the two Bands from the drop down menus.
- Select start and finish dates.
- Click + *Add now*.

You can also use the tabs on this page to select different groups for Battles, e.g. battles between year groups or even boys vs girls within a maths band.
