We end the year with a very healthy bank balance of $\pounds 8,378$ and look forward to working with school towards the outdoor improvements.

As we move into the new year, we look forward to welcoming our new school reps Miss Pullen and Miss Hitchens. We hope that you enjoy working with our team and we can continue together to provide great activities and funds for great resources for our school.
