

Welcome Leaflet For Parents/Carers

Before & After School Club for children 3 to 11 years

<u>Welcome</u>

At the Deanery we offer a before and after school club called Foxes. The club is highly successful and extremely popular and is run from our purpose built self-contained building called The Foxes Club. The children who attend Foxes enjoy a caring, safe and fun environment, full of activities and opportunities to play, learn and socialise. All children are welcome to attend as the club caters for children from ages 3 to 11.

Registration/Contract Form

An annual registration form and contract must be completed for every child that attends Foxes Club (this is an Ofsted regulation). Once you have registered your child, you are then asked to book the hours that you require for your child/children on a termly basis and to pay in advance. An Administration fee of £30.00 per family per year is due for registration purposes (£10.00 per term non- refundable).

We accept childcare vouchers as payment, please speak to the school office for more details. You can also pay by debit card online or by cash. Once sessions have been booked they cannot be cancelled or amended and must be paid for in full.

Please note there is a £30 charge per child per 15 minutes for late collection (past 6pm). Please also note that you are required to be on site 5 minutes before your session ends in order to be off the premises by the time the register is taken at 5pm. Any children still here for the 5pm register will incur an additional charge.
