Pre-Loved Uniform

These items continue to sell well through the Facebook page, coffee mornings and other events such as parents evening. There is a waiting list for many bigger size jumpers and cardigans, we will put a request out to parents towards the end of term for any good quality donations of clothes.

Pens Pens

We are continuing to sell these from the Key Stage 2 playground for Years 4-6 on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 50p each. This is much cheaper than the RRP.

Easter Disco

This was another successful event, generating a total profit of £1,494.57.

The Committee felt this had been one of the most successful Discos in a while, aided by a number of different factors including;

- more focussed roles for volunteer parents and a reduction in numbers of volunteers
- a larger core group of the 'Disco team' in attendance who are very familiar with their roles
- splitting craft and Tattoo/ nail areas into two different rooms
- an excellent DJ.

A total of 377 attended which shows the popularity of the event and the majority of tickets are now through online sales which helps greatly with admin procedures.
