



How to choose a Nursery

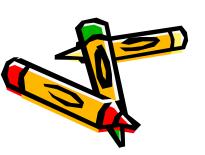
- Word of mouth reputation, including children's enjoyment and safety.

- Facilities and equipment with a good range of activities
- Staff qualifications

About our Nursery

- 52 place part-time purpose-built Nursery
- Part of our school, its policies and procedures.
- Run as an Early Years Unit with Reception
- Plan with Reception staff





Our Staff

- 1 teacher and at least 3 NVQ Level 3 equivalent teaching assistants.
- 1:13 ratio in 3 groups with a 'Key Worker'.
- Managed by an Early Years practitioner

We follow the Early Years Foundation Curriculum (Sept. 2012)

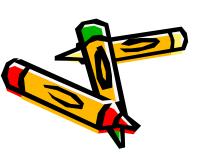
- 7 areas of learning:

Specific Areas:


- 4. Literacy

Foundation Stage Assessment

All children are assessed in accordance with development matters leading to Early Learning Goals

- Start of Nursery
- End of Nursery


Nursery assessment is sent to the Reception Teacher at each child's school

- progress tracked each half-term by staff.
- Consultation Evenings to report progress
 October and February.
- End of year report July




Induction

- Open Sessions presentation 2021
- Application to our Nursery (Nursery Criteria) further application necessary for Reception 2021 (Reception Criteria)
- Closing date for application Friday 29th March
- Offering of places by 1st May
- Nursery Parent Induction Evening-Notified in offer letter (June)
- Home Visits in September
- Staggered sessions September (either Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday)

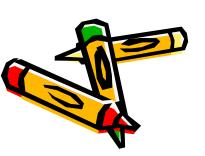
