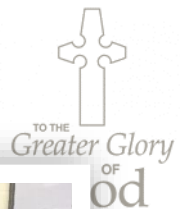

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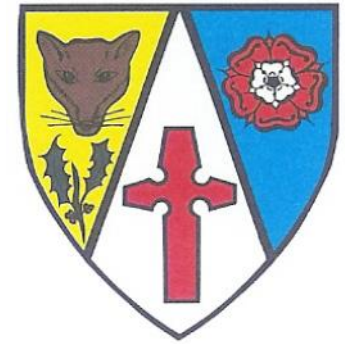
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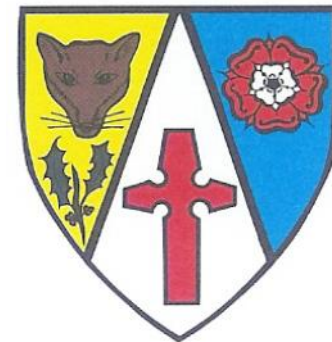
# Deanery CE Primary School- Developments



- 2005/6 New library and classroom refurbishment programme started
- 2008 Re-design of FS/KS1, building of New Early Years Unit (Rec & Nursery)
- 2009 New FS/KS1 ICT suite, Solar panels, Creation of Pond and Garden area, Re-roofing whole school, Replacement doors and windows
- 2011 Completion of all classroom refurbishment, Y5/6 toilets and cloakroom upgrade, Y1/2 toilets upgrade
- 2013/2014 Re-design and refurbishment KS2 areas, PPA room
- 2013/2014 New reception entrance and office and senior leadership office
- 2015/16 Re-design and refurbishment KS1 shared teaching areas
- 2016/2017 Stage lighting and sound system (PTFA)
- 2017/2018 Perimeter path and MUGA, new blinds and lighting
- 2018/2019 KS1 hall decorated, new kitchen doors



# Deanery CE Primary School-Academy Status



- As an OFSTED 'Outstanding' school – we converted as an Academy in 2011
- Academies are independent state funded schools – we are not connected to Birmingham Local Authority
- We set our own curriculum
- We employ our own staff
- We set and operate our own admissions process
- We are responsible for our own finance and buildings
- We follow statutory regulations set by Government
- Freedom to spend funding to suit our school and our children – LA does not retain any of our budget.
- Annual external reviews for finance, standards, performance
- We have talented, experienced governors who work to support the school, but also question and analyse all aspects of school life.

- Statutory Inspection of Anglican Schools – March 2014

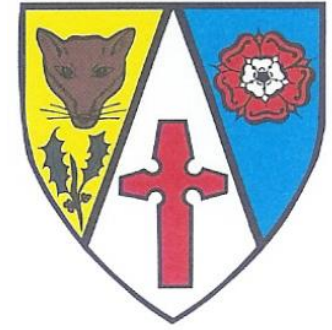

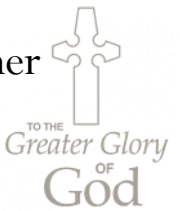

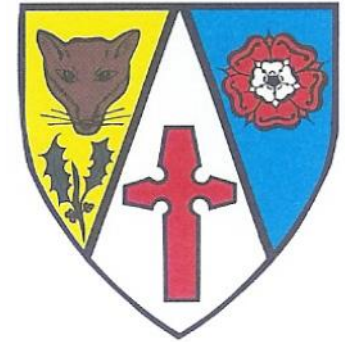

# Deanery CE Primary School- After School and Extended Services

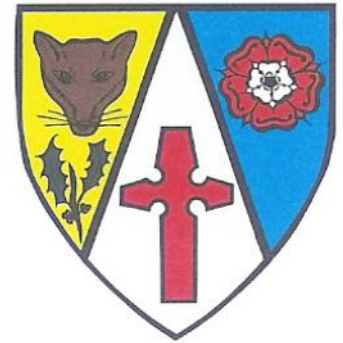


- Foxes Before and After School Club

- Achieved 'Quality in Play' award June 2012



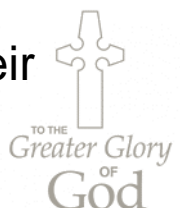


# Deanery CE Primary School- School Structure



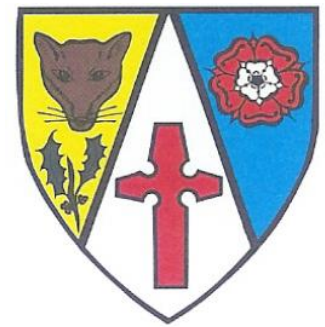
- Two form entry, 30 children per class, with 2 classes per year group.

Continual on-going assessment and monitoring of progress

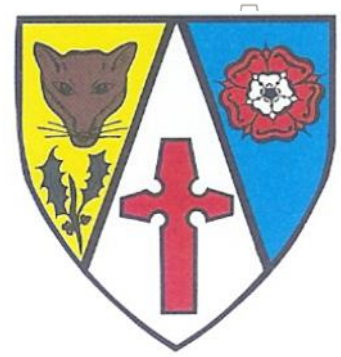

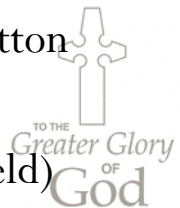


- **Preference Form** - sent to LA (online application only)

  - Children with parents with CE faith (live & worship in the old Deanery of Sutton Coldfield)\*
  - Children with parents with other Christian faith (live & worship in the old Deanery of Sutton Coldfield)\*
  - Children who attended Little Hollies Nursery & live in the old Deanery of Sutton Coldfield)
  - Children who live nearest to the school (straight line)

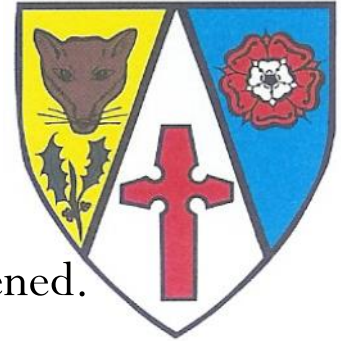

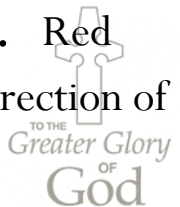

## What does our school badge mean?

- Canon Barry Harper designed our badge in 1980 when the school first opened.
- A Fox, and Holly, for its location in Fox Hollies Road, Walmley.

(The “Holly” in the Christmas Carol – a symbol of Christ’s passion -

Jesus said: “Foxes have holes, and the birds of the air their nests; but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head” Matt.8:20 Luke 9:58)

- The Tudor Rose; for Sutton Coldfield.
- The Celtic Cross. The Cross is the symbol of the Christian faith. Red reminds us that Christ shed His blood for us. An empty Cross which reminds us of the Resurrection of Jesus. A Celtic Cross to indicate the long heritage of the Christian faith.

- The white arrow – pointing up to Heaven.

Jesus said “I go to prepare a place for you...” John 14 chpt2

- Colours for School Houses:
- Red (Burgess) – Yellow (Fox) – Blue (Tudor) – Green (Hollies)
