What is the PTFA and why do we have one?

We have been an integral part of the school for a number of years and raised thousands of pounds which has been spent on equipment and resources to enhance our children's educational experiences and the schools facilities.

We are a registered charity and are working hard to develop strong links with the local community. With much needed support from parents and staff, the PTFA can continue to be successful in its efforts. You are automatically a member of our PTFA when your child joins our school.

How do we raise money?

Most of our funds are raised through the events that we run. We aim to ensure our families have fun whilst raising money for the school! We try to make events affordable and enjoyable for everyone. Over the last few years we have held adult quizzes, children's discos, an adult only comedy night, raffles, Christmas Fayre and Deanery Fest. We also sell Second hand school uniform via our <u>uniform facebook page</u>. We are exploring lots of other options and always welcome new ideas.

What do we use the funds raised for?

The money we raise is spent on the activities and resources that are not provided by the school's budget, making our children's learning experiences so much more fulfilling and exciting. We welcome funding requests from staff, parents and the school council. Our constitution commits the funds that we raise to things that will benefit the children directly.

In previous years we have co-funded sound and lighting systems, contributed to the Multi Use Games Area on the school playground, contributed to the KS1 Adventure Playground, purchased learning tablets and for the past few years we have taken the whole school to the pantomime at Christmas time.

How often do we meet?

We meet on the second Tuesday of every half term either on school premises or via Zoom. Our meetings start at 7:30pm. You do not need to be on the committee to attend meetings. Likewise, you do not need to attend meetings to be involved with our events.

How do we get information to you?

How can I get involved?

There are lots of ways that you can help and support your children through the PTFA. Offering to help is so valuable, it doesn't matter if you don't want to hold an 'official role', can't help on a regular basis, or if you cannot come into school. There are always jobs that need to be done if you have half an hour to spare (e.g. preparing raffle tickets, creating posters, contacting people for raffle prizes). Let us know if you have any contacts or skills that we could utilise, if you work for a company that provides matched funding opportunities. Any offer of help is particularly valuable to us.
