

## English – Writing

- Using different styles of writing and key features of them.
- Using a joined style of handwriting ensuring that all letters are formed correctly in all written work.
- Learning and using spelling patterns including prefixes and suffixes.

## Reading

- Reading as class, in groups and individually. Discussing texts and answering questions about them.
- Grammar including contractions and using apostrophes.
- Learning how to use different types of vocabulary including suffixes and prefixes.
- Extended reading of a range of texts for speed and fluency.

## Maths– Measurement

- Learning to tell the time to 5 minute intervals on an analogue clock face.
- Describing movement and turns.
- Using the terminology clockwise and anti-clockwise.
- Measuring mass, capacity and temperature including which units to use.

## Science

- To investigate the conditions needed for plants to grow.
- To create a variety of food chains and spot patterns in them.
- To design an ideal habitat for a specific animal.
- Use skills of investigation including prediction, experimentation, data collection, interpretation and drawing conclusions.
