

## Year 3 Autumn Term

### English

Using the text 'Chalk', create text for a picture book through verbal story re-telling, speech bubbles and play scripts.

Read the poetry story 'Dinosaurumpus' and explore rhyming couplets, alliteration, onomatopoeia and similes. Write our own poems in the style of the story.

Write stories and diary accounts based on a day in the life of a dinosaur.

### Non-Fiction

To create dinosaur fact files and present information in writing and in typed form.

Write instructions for making a sandwich in DT.

### PE – Football and Handball

Throw and catch with control and accuracy.

Strike a ball and field with control.

Follow the rules of the game and play fairly.

### PSHE

Cooperation: Play games and take part in activities to develop good co-operation skills.

Friendships: Listen to stories involving friendship issues and take part in discussions and role play activities to solve problems.

### History

To use evidence to ask questions and determine truth or myth about dinosaurs. Explore reasons for dinosaur extinction theories. Place Triassic, Jurassic and Cretaceous periods on a time line using dates.



### Computing

#### Computer Science

To design, write and debug algorithms in a simple game using Scratch. Learn how to use tinkering and logical reasoning to develop and enhance their games.

### Music

Learn to sing 'Let Your Spirit Fly' by Joanna Mangon, in tune with accurate pitch from memory. Learn how to control voices and breathing and perform the song to an audience. Play rhythm and pitch games.

### Science

Animals including humans.

To identify that animals and humans need the right types and amount of nutrition.

Describe how humans and animals have skeletons and muscles for protection and movement.

Describe the physical and mental importance of a healthy lifestyle.

### RE

Explore the Christian views of the Creation story and the role that Christians have to play as stewards or caretakers of the earth.

Explore how beliefs about right and wrong can effect people's behaviour.

### Art

Design images of dinosaur extinction theories by selecting and arranging materials for collage.

Paint a picture based on the story of the Creation In RE. Use a variety of brush techniques.

### MFL

Introducing basic conversation to meet and greet. Use Spanish songs to consolidate new vocabulary.

Begin to create and use a glossary to record words and phrases.

### Geography

Explore maps of the world and identify locations of fossil remains. Locate continents and explore how they have changed over time.

### Maths

Number and place value

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, and ones).
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Solve number problems and
- Practical problems.
- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, and 50.

Addition and subtraction

- Add and subtract numbers mentally, up to a three-digit number and hundreds.
- Add and subtract using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction.

### DT

Healthy Eating. Experience a taste test for ingredients for a sandwich. Disassemble products to understand how they work. Design a sandwich for a child's dinosaur themed party. Learn how to use cutting materials safely and select appropriate tools.
