## SCIENCE

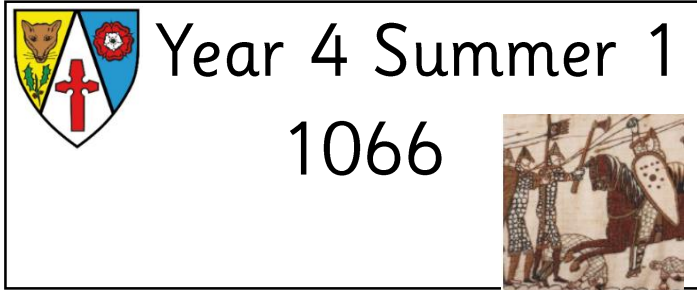
- Use classification keys to search for living things in our local and wider environment
