MATHS

- Convert between mm, cm, m and km
- Add and subtract lengths
- Measure perimeter of a rectangle and rectilinear shapes
- To be able to multiply and divide by 1, 10 and 100
- Multiply and divide by 3, 6, 7 and 9

SCIENCE

- Use classification keys to search for living things in our local environment
- Finding pitch and volume of different instruments and sounds
- Describe the basic parts of the digestive system in humans through making our own model
- Construct series circuits involving more components
- Observe materials changing state through practical investigations

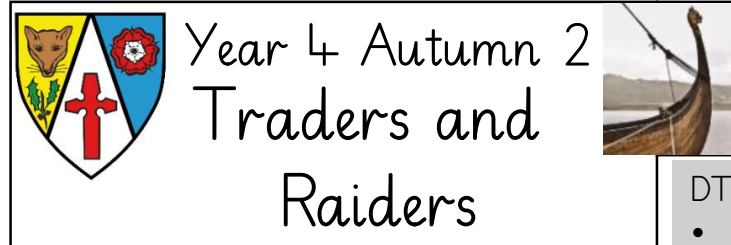
In order to commit our learning to long-term memory, we will revisit and build upon our understanding of these concepts in the Spring term.
