

GEOGRAPHY

- Use maps to identify
 - Saxon shore forts.
 - Where Viking raiders came from.
 - Saxon settlements in Britain
 - Sites of specific interest in the South-West of the UK
 - Alfred the Great and the Viking King Guthrum's territories and kingdoms.

MATHS

- Subtract 3 and 4 digit numbers.
- Convert between mm, cm, m and km
- Add and subtract lengths
- Measure perimeter of a rectangle and rectilinear shapes
- To be able to multiply and divide by 1, 10 and 100
- Multiply and divide by 3, 6, 7 and 9

SCIENCE

- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C).
- Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.

In order to commit our learning to long-term memory, we will revisit and build upon our understanding of these concepts in the Spring term
