## Countdown to EASTER

At Foxes we love Easter! We love the chocolate treats and the traditional egg hunt and all the fun of Easter.

Parents have asked why we send some snacks home with a note explaining why they cannot have these items in Foxes.

The reason is we have a few children with special dietary needs. This means we ask parents not to pack unlabelled food as we may be unable to ascertain whether these items contain allergens which could be unsafe for those who have hypersensitivity to certain foods.

Foxes also caters for under 5's, so we also ask that parents help us to reduce the risk of choking by:

- removing any stones and pips from fruit
- cut small round foods, like grapes, strawberries and cherry tomatoes into quarters
- do not give nuts, seeds or popcorn as a snack
- do not give children sweets
