

# To all Reception parents, and particularly those that are new to the Deanery...

This half term you will be receiving a flyer about our PTFA Summer Disco on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July. It is always a popular event and if it will be your child's first disco, the PTFA Disco Committee thought it would be helpful for you to know a bit more about this event:

- The KS1 disco is open to children in Reception, Year One and Year Two.
- It starts at 5:00pm and finishes at 6:15pm.
- Children are dropped off at **the KS2 entrance** to the school (the far left corner of the staff car park as you look at the school).
- We now have online booking facilities for you to be able to buy your child's ticket and volunteer to help at the disco. This can be done at <a href="www.pta-events.co.uk/deanery">www.pta-events.co.uk/deanery</a> where you will need to register. We strongly encourage you to use our online booking system but do also have offline ticket request forms available at the school office if needed. Ticket sales will go live on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June and close on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> July. Tickets will then be issued on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July. The office will have a list of tickets issued if you have not received your tickets and are concerned.
- The request also asks for two different emergency contacts. It is really important that these
  apply for the whole time your child is at the disco, even if you are helping out, as we may
  need to contact you quickly, please note that a ticket will not be issued without this contact
  information.
- Children with medical needs that may require intervention will be required to have an adult attend with them. Any child with asthma in KS1 will need an adult to attend who will be responsible for the inhaler and any administration required.
- It is helpful to have lots of parents volunteering to help on the night. This is also a great way of checking that your child is happy at their first disco, but we do encourage you to 'take a back seat' and encourage your child to be independent, there are many volunteers there to help them throughout the event.
- There will be items available to buy. These include glitter tattoos (which can be removed easily using baby oil/ olive oil), nail painting, craft items and small toys. Therefore, most parents send their children with some change (between about £3 and £5 is normal). Don't worry if your children don't know all the coins we will help them.
- At the end of the disco, children are dismissed from the KS1 hall (parents should enter via the main entrance). We will have the children safely behind tables with sign-out sheets. It is vitally important that each parent signs before taking a child, so that we know they have been taken home safely.

Hope this helps, and that we see lots of new faces there!!!


